Vaccination is one of the most important ways to protect your dog from serious and potentially life-threatening diseases. Vaccinations help build immunity, reduce disease spread, and support lifelong health and wellbeing.



1 WHAT ARE VACCINATIONS?

Vaccinations stimulate your dog's immune system to recognise and fight infectious diseases.

Vaccinations help protect against:

- ✓ Canine Parvovirus
- ✓ Canine Distemper
- ✓ Canine Hepatitis (Adenovirus)
- ✓ Kennel Cough
- ✓ Leptospirosis (high-risk dogs)
- ✓ Canine Coronavirus (high-risk dogs)



DID YOU KNOW?

Many serious canine diseases are preventable through routine vaccination.

2 WHY VACCINATE YOUR DOG?

Vaccination helps:

- ✓ Protect individual dogs from serious disease
- ✓ Reduce disease transmission in the community
- ✓ Minimise treatment costs associated with preventable illness
- ✓ Support a longer, healthier life



3 C3 VACCINATION

C3 protects against:

- ✓ Canine Distemper
- ✓ Canine Parvovirus
- ✓ Canine Adenovirus (Hepatitis)



Adult dogs:

- Annual booster vaccinations

4 C5 VACCINATION

C5 includes all C3 protection plus:

- ✓ Bordetella bronchiseptica (Kennel Cough)
- ✓ Canine Parainfluenza

Recommended for:

- All pet dogs
- Dogs attending boarding kennels
- Dogs attending grooming salons
- Dogs attending dog parks, training or social activities



Adult dogs:

- Annual booster vaccinations

5 C7 VACCINATION

C7 includes all C5 protection plus:

- ✓ Leptospirosis
- ✓ Canine Coronavirus

Recommended for:

- Pigeon dogs
- Hunting dogs
- High-risk working dogs



Adult dogs:

- Annual booster vaccinations

6 PUPPY VACCINATION SCHEDULE

	6 Weeks	C2i/C3 or C5 *
	8 Weeks	C2i/C3 or C5 *
	12 Weeks	C3 or C5
	14-16 Weeks	Final puppy vaccination
	Annual	Booster vaccination and health check

- C2i recommended for at risk puppies.



DID YOU KNOW?

Completing the full puppy course is essential for optimal protection.

7 KENNEL COUGH PROTECTION

Kennel Cough is a highly contagious respiratory disease spread through contact with other dogs.

Signs may include:

- Persistent cough
- Gagging
- Nasal discharge
- Reduced exercise tolerance



Vaccination significantly reduces the risk and severity of infection.

8 PROHEART SR-12

ProHeart SR-12 provides protection against Heartworm disease.

Heartworm is spread by mosquitoes and can cause serious damage to the heart and lungs.

Protocol:

- ✓ First injection at 6 months of age
- ✓ Repeat every 12 months



Annual heartworm prevention is recommended for all dogs.

- ✓ Vaccination protects against serious infectious diseases.

- ✓ C7 vaccination is recommended for piggling and high-risk working dogs.
